Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club as the defender is pleased to announce it is accepting challenges for the "WALT ELLIOTT CHALLENGE RACE", to be held on April 15, 2017 at CBYC.

The Challenge shall be sailed in monohull yachts propelled by sails. Each yacht shall be skippered by a member of the club which it represents, and only a member of such club may steer the yacht during the races for the cup.

Any member club of the ASPBYC may challenge CBYC for the Challenge Trophy. Such challenge shall be in writing, signed by a flag officer of the challenging club and must state the name of the challenging club and submitted to CBYC not later than March 1st 2017. The challenge shall state the class or handicap rule under which each yacht must be rated, and if a handicap rule, a rating with which each challenging and defending yacht shall have a rating that is not more than (5%) higher or lower.

The race shall be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the "The Racing Rule of Sailing" and the Accepted Challenge.

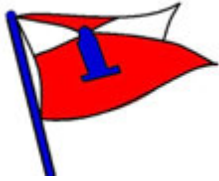

NOTICE OF RACE

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the current 2017-2020 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing as amended and adopted by USSA, except as amended by the CBYC Sailing Instructions and this NOR. Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The office notice board is outside the CBYC clubhouse.

CLASS: Catalina 37's owned by the Long Beach Sailing Foundation.

ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open all Association of San Pedro Bay Yacht Clubs. The skipper must be a flag officer of the club they represent, 50% of the crew must be active members of the club they are representing, total crew will be 8 and the crew list must be submitted and posted on the host club web site. Each boat shall fly its' clubs burgee from its' back stay. Each participating club shall provide one person to serve on the protest committee.

ENTRIES & FEES: Entry cards are available at the CBYC clubhouse and web site and must be filed with the race committee prior to April 8, 2017. There is no entry fee, however LBYC request a donation of \$50 to the Long Beach Sailing Foundation. Skipper meeting will be at 1030 hour of race day in the LBYC clubhouse.

RACE SCHEDULE: There will be three races scheduled. The first warning will be at 1255 hours. The start of the second race will be as soon as possible after the completion of the first race. No race will start after 1700 hours.

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The courses for these races will be selected from the CBYC Course Chart/Sailing Instruction 2017 and any posted supplements. Start/Finish area as posted the race board will be used. The CBYC Course Chart/Sailing Instruction 2017 is available at the CBYC clubhouse.
